Naming Opportunities

The 4209 Folsom Avenue Campus.....\$2,000,000

The campus encompasses the building and grounds of City Garden’s elementary and junior high students and will be a beautiful, innovative landmark within the Botanical Heights neighborhood.

The Entry Pavilion.....\$1,000,000

Serves as City Garden’s front door to the community. The Entry Pavilion will be a vibrant and welcoming entrance and will support City Garden’s commitment to accessibility, with elevator access to both floors.

The 4209 Folsom Ave Building Exterior (naming opportunity secured)\$1,000,000

4209 Folsom Avenue will be the permanent home to City Garden’s elementary and junior high students and will be a beautiful, innovative landmark within the Botanical Heights neighborhood.

The Entry Reception & Living Room.....\$750,000

A community space at the entrance, with places to sit, meet, and collaborate. It includes an area for hospitality and the Junior High store. It is welcoming and highly visible.

The Community Room.....\$500,000

A large, multi-functional space accommodating community gatherings, Anti-Bias, Antiracism (ABAR) trainings, neighborhood meetings, parent and family events, as well as gross motor activities, before and after care programming, and student performances. This room is visible and connected to the reception area, and will be part of the first impression for visitors.

The Outdoor Playground.....\$500,000

A large playground area boasting a half-court basketball, hopscotch, four square, and playground equipment.

The Multi-Purpose Room.....\$250,000

A large space primarily intended for the music program, P.E. and Spanish specials classes. All levels of students will use the space.

The Junior High Community Commons.....\$250,000

A community area for Junior High with a common area, four classrooms, and shared kitchen; space for socializing and group work.

The Upper Elementary Community Commons.....\$250,000

A community area for Upper Elementary with a common area, four classrooms, and shared kitchen; space for socializing and group work.

The Lower Elementary Community Commons.....\$250,000

A large, open area connecting the Lower Elementary classrooms with space for student work and projects that will connect the Lower Elementary classroom.

- The Entry Plaza.....\$250,000**
The space between the entry pavilion and parking along Folsom Avenue where the community enters and also serves as an outdoor gathering space.

- The Exploration Lab.....\$100,000**
A multi-purpose lab space for Outdoor Education program and STEM curriculum.

- The North Greenspace.....\$100,000**
Walking trail and natural play area on the North side of the building.

- The Main Kitchen.....\$100,000**
The Main Kitchen facility will provide meals for students, and will also be used for nutrition education.

- The Outdoor Playground.....\$75,000**
A smaller playground area, on the East side of the building, with playground equipment and open space to play.

- The Large Conference Areas (2).....\$50,000 (each)**
A series of rooms with capacity for 10 to 12 people. These rooms will primarily be used by Specialists when there is a need for services outside the classroom, and small group projects/instruction; 2 large conference rooms available.

- The Small Conference Areas (2).....\$25,000 (each)**
A series of rooms with capacity for 4 to 6 people. These rooms will primarily be used by Specialists when there is a need for services outside the classroom, and small group projects/instruction; 5 small conference rooms available.

- The Community Use Area - Family Restroom.....\$25,000**
As a core part of City Garden’s culture of radical hospitality, the Community Use Area (specifically the Family Restroom) will offer basic services to families.

- The Community Use Area - Nursing Mother Room.....\$25,000**
As a core part of City Garden’s culture of radical hospitality, the Community Use Area (specifically the Nursing Mother Room) will offer basic services to families.

- The Community Use Area – Laundry Room.....\$25,000**
As a core part of City Garden culture of radical hospitality, the Community Use Areas (specifically the Laundry Room) will offer basic services to families.

- A Memorial or Tribute Tree.....\$10,000**
Beautify the grounds of City Garden by contributing a tree for our outdoor environment.

- A Memorial or Tribute Bench.....\$10,000**
Beautify the grounds of City Garden by contributing a bench for our outdoor environment.

- An Alumni Profile.....\$5,000**
Sponsor a Graduate Profile plaque as part of our Alumni Wall, celebrating the lasting impact of our City Garden mission.

- A Student Spotlight.....\$1,000**
