We began in 2008 with 53 students; we will have 400 children in preschool through eighth grade when we begin our 2021-22 school year. As we grow, we continue to seek individuals to join us who share our vision for academic excellence for all children and holistic Montessori education, rooted in equity and social justice.

Reading Specialist

As City Garden embarks on our expansion plan, we're seeking to hire a Reading Specialist for the start of our 2021-22 school year.

The Reading Specialist will have the responsibility for providing intervention that improves student achievement in reading and composition skills, with an overall goal of advancing the academic skills needed for success. They will build on a student-centered environment which fosters relationships and promotes continual growth for students and staff.

The Most Exciting Part of the Job

- Inspiring students to strengthen their reading skills
- Collaborating with teachers and the Special Services team to identify children who have reading difficulties, and to assist those children in developing their abilities
- Serving as a reading consultant and a reading resource person
- Creating an environment that demonstrates rapport with, respect, and kindness for all students as well as between students
- Coming from a place of grounding in anti-bias education and antiracist values and principles, and is excited to be part of a school that is reimagining education through these lenses
- Engaging deeply with students, teachers, staff and families as partners
- Participates in school functions, including but not limited to Parent and Guardian Conferences, Open Houses, Transition Nights, Curriculum Nights, Parent Orientations and the Family Field Day

Responsibilities

- Works with the Special Services team to identify, diagnose and assist children who have reading difficulties
- Provides targeted reading instruction for identified students
- Assists in the establishment and development of reading curriculum
- Monitors students' progress and provides frequent updates to staff and parents
- Adapts instructional techniques to meet the diverse needs of individual students
- Helps ensure the learning environment is dynamic and conducive to high-level learning

- Missouri Teacher Certification
- At least 3 years of teaching experience required; 5 years preferred, preferably in a public or urban setting
- Knowledge of the Missouri Learning Standards and Common Core Standards
- Demonstrated success working with a diverse student population
- Deeply grounded in racial equity and have strong alignment with antibias, anti-racism values
- Being child-centered, flexible, and willing to do whatever it takes for our students
