# Rethinking hunger and food security

TO commemorate World Hunger Day, which was marked yesterday, the Community Chest, in partnership with the Southern Africa Food Lab, launched a new publication that reflects on the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on hunger and food security.

Titled “World Hunger day 2020 Challenging False Narratives in a Global Crisis: Reflections on Human Rights, Inequality and Securing Food Systems”, the compilation was written by academic, business and community experts on food systems and security from South Africa, Nigeria, Ghana and the US.

The papers reflect on human rights, equality and securing food systems, and the contributors offer fresh insights and recommendations, including building new food systems and giving a sense of what it will take to build them.
