Leaving a Bequest to Diamond Women

How do I leave a Bequest to Diamond Women?

If you already have a Will, you can easily make a minor change or addition to your Will with your solicitor called a Codicil. It's straightforward and can be done for free if you work with a Public Trust Officer.

Here's how you can include Diamond Women in your Will:

- A specific dollar amount or a percentage of your estate
- The residue (the remainder of your estate after your bequests to loved ones has been distributed) of your estate or a percentage of it
- Real estate, shares, collections, assets, insurance policies and annuities

Suggested wording for your Bequest

"I give, free of all duties and taxes (choose one of the following)

- the whole of my estate (or _____% of my estate), *or*
- the residue of my estate (or _____% of the residue of my estate), *or*
- the sum of \$_____, or my units/shares in _____ Trust/Ltd, *or*
- my real property (or _____% of my property) situated at (address) having the title reference _____, *or*
- the proceeds from the sale of _____* as liquidated by the executor of the estate* sale of a specific item such as artwork, jewellery etc.

The receipt of the treasurer, secretary or public officer for the time being of Diamond Women is an absolute discharge to my executor.

Without creating a binding obligation on my executor or Diamond Women, I request that Diamond Women to use these funds if at all practicable for this purpose or the purpose in its absolute discretion which most closely matches this purpose and failing that for the general purposes of Diamond Women.
