



ShareTek Powers New Criminal Diversion Program in Yavapai County

The high-touchpoint case management solution enables workers to improve client compliance and engagement

Scottsdale, AZ (October 7th, 2020) – [ShareTek](#), formerly known as True Mobile Health, LLC, a provider of shared technology for next-generation client engagement and coordinated care, today announced its involvement in the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors' newly developed Criminal Offender Diversion Program. This program provides low-level offenders an opportunity to avoid a traditional jail sentence, while simultaneously improving public safety and saving the county money. ShareTek will power the technology behind the program with its robust, HIPAA-compliant solution that is equipped with timed GPS monitoring, a case management dashboard and secure at-home testing for over 100 substances.

"We are incredibly proud to provide a coordinated care platform for Yavapai County's Criminal Offender Diversion Program and look forward to celebrating its future success in helping low-level offenders with a second chance at a full, healthy and productive life," said ShareTek President and Founder Steve Moak Jr. "My own journey to sobriety fueled a passion to help reduce the stigma for individuals experiencing addiction and offer the necessary tools for others to overcome similar struggles."

According to the [National Institute of Justice](#), diversionary programs like the one introduced in Yavapai County are more economical than the normal court process for minor crimes, and more effective at reducing recidivism. Yavapai County has noted an increase in illegal drug use offenses since the program's inception, and the new initiative will encourage participation in treatment for substance abuse and mental health concerns that would otherwise contribute to re-entry into the correctional system if not cared for proactively. Enlisting ShareTek's solution will cost a fraction of the \$145 per day currently spent by the county to jail each low-level offender.

Enabling comprehensive coordination of the individual's care team across healthcare, human service and criminal justice staff, ShareTek connects vulnerable and at-risk populations with the care they need, keeping them fully engaged throughout the course of their individual treatment plans. With DNA-matching technology and a HIPAA-compliant video function, ShareTek's at-home and at-work drug tests permit dignity and convenience, while helping to destigmatize the substance abuse testing process and improve overall client engagement.

ShareTek's drug testing kits can detect a broad spectrum of illegal drugs, alcohol and prescription substances compared to most traditional tests. This provides care teams with a reliable means of determining an offender's success at remaining clean, while also reporting on the levels of any substance detected and any medication abuse. The drug testing process will be applied to an offender's individual plan, under the guidance of Yavapai County's team of diversion program experts.

As part of the new initiative, Yavapai's county attorney will determine each offender's eligibility and will assign a case manager to develop an individualized program. Most programs will occur over a three-to-six-month period, with the possibility to extend as needed to ensure client success. Upon successful completion of the diversion program, offenders will be dismissed of all charges and become free to pursue a productive life, with an increased chance of lasting

recovery. ShareTek's solution will enable case workers in Yavapai County to track compliance with program goals and restrictions, offering a GPS function to ensure offenders remain within permissible geographic boundaries and providing a mobile platform to complement existing meetings and check-ins with the care team.

"We are hopeful this pilot program in Yavapai County will set the stage for other counties throughout Arizona—as well as other states—to implement similar diversionary programs," said Moak Jr. "We are pleased to be offering a solution that truly benefits everyone involved."
