Application and registration process:

First year students: Upon receipt of the completed application form and **R1 000 application fee**, an interview will be arranged with you. You will need to bring along a portfolio if this is requested. If accepted to study at Oakfields College, the registration form should be completed and a **R2 000 registration fee** paid. NB if not accepted, R500 of the application fee will be refunded. Otherwise, the full amount is forfeited.

Second year students: A registration form should be completed and a **R3 000 registration fee** paid.
