## Part 3: First Priorities and Last Resorts

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### INTRODUCTION

Part 3 unpacks the importance of prayer. It doesn't give us an excuse *not* to step into those big moments of leadership, but allows us to partner *with* God in those big moments of leadership.

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### LET'S TALK ABOUT IT

2. Share your thoughts about this concept: Intelligent sensible leaders *do more than pray, but they don't do anything until they pray.*
3. What keeps you from engaging in prayer?
4. What is a situation in your life right now that you need to take before God in prayer?

### THIS WEEK

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Schedule time to invite God into the situation you shared with the group this week. See how He may prompt you to continue to either press into the situation *with* Him or let it go *to* Him. Regardless of how He calls you to respond, stand ready to receive His peace and refreshment.

Consider updating your group with the result of your prayer time with God.
