

NYC + NYS CLIMATE LEGISLATION

NY CITY 80x50

In September 2014, NYC committed to reducing its greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions 80% by 2050, with an interim target of reducing them 40% by 2030 (40x30).

NY CITY ONE NYC 2050

Released in 2015, OneNYC 2050 is NYC's long-term strategic plan which aims to achieve carbon neutrality and 100 percent clean electricity by 2050. CreateNYC's implementation strategy appointed an energy specialist to work with cultural organizations to help them decrease their energy use and lower their environmental impact.

NY CITY CLIMATE MOBILIZATION ACT

Passed in 2019, the centerpiece is a bill that will require large and medium-sized buildings to reduce their emissions 40% by 2030 and 80% by 2050.

NY STATE CLIMATE LEADERSHIP & PROTECTION ACT

In 2019, NY State committed to an 85% reduction in GHG emissions by 2050, 100% carbon-free electricity by 2040, 70% renewable energy by 2030, and 22 Million Tons of Carbon Reduction through energy efficiency and electrification.
