All eyes were on you and your gown - the centerpiece of your very special day. You invested a great amount of time choosing the perfect gown for you, now choose the perfect company to help you preserve those memories for the generations to come.

Preservation of your gown begins with a careful and complete inspection for both visible and hidden stains by our certified experts. Our experts are trained to look for common stains like red wine, cake spots, and hem area dirt, but they do not stop there. Using a carefully crafted process, our experts look your gown over for champagne stains, perspiration marks and others not immediately visible to the naked eye.

Our professionals then gently remove stains by hand, careful not to miss even the slightest of blemishes.

Finally, your gown is cleaned, reinspected and pressed for packaging.

Once your gown is completely cleaned and restored to its wedding day beauty, it is skilfully shaped and folded using acid-free paper between each fold. Only completely acid-free paper will ever be used on your gown as only the best tissue is good enough to protect it from the harmful effects of air and light, while traditional and ordinary papers can yellow your gown and possibly cause permanent damage.

Your gown is placed in an acid-free box with acid-free tissue and additionally wrapped in acid-free muslin. White gloves are included in your box in the event the gown is opened and handled after the preservation. The entire box is placed inside an acid-free muslin bag for storage. *All dresses should be stored in the box, placed flat, and in an area that is room temperature year round. The fabric should never be exposed to extreme temperatures or dampness.

Your gown is guaranteed by the Association of Wedding Gown Specialists. Future pressing and use of the gown is handled free of charge by hundreds of certified specialists around the globe in the Association of Wedding Gown Specialists network.

PRICING DETAILS & GUIDELINES

Basic Cleaning & Preservation: \$350 and up

- Includes up to three items to be placed in the box - including gown.
- Veil cleaning: \$18.85 and up
- Additional charges may apply. Final pricing available at drop off/inspection.

Bride must declare value of the gown during initial consultation. The basic cleaning & preservation charge of \$350 covers any gown up to \$2,000 in value. Each additional \$1,000 of declared value would increase the basic cost by \$20.

Clean & Press Only: \$213 and up

- Gown declared value not exceeding \$2000. Each additional \$1,000 of declared value increases clean & press only cost by \$20.

Restorations: Price based on in-store inspection of gown.

Sugar Treatment Process: \$25

In the event a non-visible stain is found on the gown from a clear liquid (punch, soft drink, champagne, white wine, etc) is discovered on the dress, over time if this is not treated correctly, it will turn into a dark brown or black stain which is difficult to remove and sometimes permanent. The sugar treatment process removes these hidden stains.
