

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy has been prepared by LinkedField, Inc. (“LinkedField”). This Privacy Policy sets out the manner in which LinkedField collects, uses, discloses and otherwise manages personal information. This Privacy Policy applies to the privacy practices on our website, www.LinkedException.com (the “Website”).

Our Core Values and Code of Conduct

LinkedField’s core values are to build useful, simple software for the industry, be the best at customer support, and to promote and elevate the image of the good, hard-working people who are building the infrastructure and world we live in. Relationships and trust form the foundation of our business and they are key to our company culture. We operate our business on the basis of honesty, openness and trust with our customers, business partners, and employees.

LinkedField will not knowingly or intentionally use, share or sell your Personal Data in ways which are unrelated to the terms of use without your prior consent.

Collection & use of personal information

We may collect your personal information when you:

- Register for the LinkedField service
- Are invited to join a project within LinkedField
- Join and/or perform work at a construction project site

Registration

You may be asked to provide certain personal information to sign up for our services, including your name, mobile phone number and email address. The personal information collected during the registration process is used to manage your account with LinkedField.

You also have the option to submit the email addresses, company, positions and mobile phone numbers of colleagues, contractors or other contacts in order to invite them to join a project.

If you believe that one of your contacts has provided us with your personal information and you would like to request that it be removed from our database, please contact us at info@LinkedException.com.

We collect billing information such as credit card number and use this for billing purposes and to fulfill your orders.

Service Provider Arrangements

We may transfer (or otherwise make available) your personal information to third parties that provide services on our behalf. For example, we may use service providers to host our Website and send out email on our behalf. We also use service providers to fulfill functions such as billing.

Your personal information may be maintained and processed by service providers in the U.S. or other foreign jurisdictions, and personal information may be accessed by law enforcement authorities in such jurisdictions.

Service providers are provided with the information they need to perform their designated functions, and we do not authorize them to use or disclose personal information for their own marketing or other purposes.

Sale of Business

We may transfer any information we have about you as an asset in conjunction with a merger or sale (including transfers made as part of insolvency or bankruptcy proceedings). You will be notified via email and/or a prominent notice on our Web site of any change in ownership or uses of your personal information.

Legal

In certain situations, LinkedField may be required to disclose personal data in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements.

LinkedField and its service providers may provide your personal information in response to a search warrant or other legally valid inquiry or order, or to an investigative body in the case of a breach of an agreement or contravention of law, or as otherwise required or permitted by applicable Canadian, U.S. or other law. We may also disclose personal information where necessary for the establishment, exercise or a defense of legal claims, or as otherwise permitted by law. When we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others, investigate fraud, or respond to a government request.

Additional information about our website

Aggregate Data

LinkedField and our third party tracking-utility partners may generate certain non-identifying and aggregate data and store it in log files. This information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and/or clickstream data. We may use this aggregated and non-identifying information to further enhance our services only. We may combine this automatically collected log information with other information we collect about you. We do this to improve services we offer you, to improve our marketing, user analytics, or site functionality.

“Tracking technologies”

Technologies such as: cookies, beacons, tags and scripts are used by LinkedField and our partners, affiliates, or analytics or service providers. LinkedField uses third-party technologies including Amazon AWS, Amplitude and Google Analytics. These technologies are used in analyzing trends, administering the site, tracking usage around the site and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole.

We use cookies for to remember users’ settings (e.g. language preference) and for authentication. Users can control the use of cookies at the individual browser level. If you reject cookies, you may still use our site, but your ability to use some features or areas of our site may be limited.

Third parties with whom we partner to provide certain features on our website or to display advertising based upon your web browsing activity also use HTML5 to collect and store information. Various browsers may offer their own management tools for removing HTML5.

Security of Personal Information

We have implemented measures designed to help protect personal information in our custody and control. We maintain reasonable administrative, technical and physical safeguards in an effort to help protect against unauthorized access, use, modification and disclosure of personal information in our custody and control.

When you provide us with sensitive information (such as your credit card number and your linked account credentials), we encrypt the transmission of that information using secure socket layer technology (SSL). No collection or transmission of information over the Internet or other publicly accessible communications networks can be guaranteed to be fully secure, however, and therefore, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any such information. Access & Removal of Your Personal information

Upon request LinkedField will provide you with information about whether we hold any of your personal information. You have the right to access, update, correct, and delete inaccuracies in your personal information in our custody and control, subject to certain exceptions prescribed by law. You may request access, updating, corrections, or deletions of inaccuracies by contacting us at the contact information provided below or by logging into your account and making the applicable changes in your Profile.

We have personal information retention processes designed to retain personal information of our customers for as long as your account is active or as needed to provide you services. We will retain and use your information as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.
