Less than 5% of Asian voters cast a vote to elect our current mayor.
By coming out to vote, South Asian voters can change the course of an election.

IMPORTANT DATES

Voter Registration Deadline – **October 8th**
Deadline to Request a Mail in Ballot – **October 18th**
In-person Early Voting Period – **October 23rd-31st**
Election Day – **November 2nd (6AM - 9PM)**

VOTER REGISTRATION

Eligibility to Register to Vote in NYC

- Be a citizen of the United States for at least 30 days
- Be a legal resident of your county
- Be 18 years of age on or before the election
- Not serving a sentence for conviction of a felony

If you don't have a record then you are not registered to vote!
If you are not registered to vote, register online with your
Driver's license at <https://voterreg.dmv.ny.gov/motorvoter/>
**You will not be able to vote in this election, but be registered
for future elections*

MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE

Vote Early -

You must visit your designated Early Voting location from
10/25-11/1 in order to vote early. Times will vary, but your
location and all of the times it is open can be found at
<https://findmypollsite.vote.nyc/>

Vote on Election Day -

Polls are open from 6AM to 9PM on election
day. Find your polling location at
<https://findmypollsite.vote.nyc/>.

**Your Early Voting location and your
Election Day location ARE NOT THE SAME.*

*Make sure to go to the appropriate location
listed using the pollsite locator.*

TIPS

If you vote in person, stay safe, wear
a mask, and abide by social distancing
standards.

When filling out a paper ballot make sure to
select only one option for each election or
question and fill in the oval completely with
a black or blue pen.

Plan to vote early as this will ensure that
you have time to vote again in case of
unexpected emergencies
