1 WASH YOUR HANDS

FOR A MINIMUM OF 20 SECONDS
OR USE HAND SANITIZER AND RUB
OVER ALL AREAS OF THE HANDS
UNTIL THEY ARE DRY.



2 DISINFECT DEVICES

THAT YOUR HANDS COME IN CONTACT
WITH BEFORE AND AFTER EACH USE.

DO NOT SPRAY
DIRECTLY ON DEVICE.
USE A CLEAN CLOTH,
PAPER TOWELS, OR
DISPOSABLE WIPES.



3 CLEAN YOUR HANDS AGAIN

IF DEVICE IS
ELECTRONICALLY POWERED,
POWER IT OFF OR UNPLUG IT
BEFORE CLEANING.



DIY DISINFECTANT

IN AN EMPTY SPRAY BOTTLE

MIX: $\frac{1}{3}$ WHITE VINEGAR

$\frac{1}{3}$ WATER

$\frac{1}{3}$ ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL
WITH 70% ALCOHOL

PREVENTION IS BETTER THAN TREATMENT
