COVID SAFETY PROTOCOL

The Florida State Fair is in the process of finalizing their Covid safety protocol for the 2021 Florida State Fair. All exhibitors and their guest will be required to adhere to these guidelines if they plan to attend and participate in the 2021 Florida State Fair. Those final details will be released prior to the show as all of these are subject to change based on local, state and federal recommendations. Anyone not following these guidelines, may be removed from participation in Florida State Fair activities.

ASK ME TALKS – CHANGED TO ASK ME TALKS VIDEO

To help with time constraints and social distancing, the Ask Me Talks will be changed to Ask Me Talk Videos.

1. To receive the full 100 points, exhibitors must submit a video of themselves working their animal for at least 30 seconds and present a short talk. The presentation of the talk must be a minimum of 2 minutes and maximum of 3 minutes.
2. **PLEASE NOTE:** Topic of Talk must relate to the Skilathon topic of Swine Products and Marketing only.
3. Exhibitors are required to be in Official Show Attire when doing the Ask Me Talks Video.
4. No posters allowed to be used during the talk.
5. Since all videos will be judged prior to the Fair, **all video registration forms with video link and script must be submitted on or before February 1, 2021.** Each exhibitor must complete the On-Line Registration Form which is located on the Florida State Fair Agribusiness website – www.floridastatefairag.com. **All videos will need to be uploaded to YouTube on or before February 1, 2021. Please keep the video open on YouTube until end of the Florida State Fair.**
6. A copy of the Written script (of talk) (see attached Ask Me Talks form) must be submitted with video submission on Google Form. Script can be uploaded as JPEG or PDF.
7. Videos become property of the Florida State Fair with rights to publish for promotion or training.
8. See page 16 of the Swine Rules and Regulations for the Swine Ask Me Talk Scoring Rubric.
9. For instructions on how to submit your video and registration form, refer to page 15 of the Swine Rules. The process is explained in the Pre-Fair Promotional Video rules.

CHANGES IN BARN AND SHOW RING LAYOUT

We will have the Show Ring inside the TECO Arena and the swine pens will be place in the North Cattle Barn.

LIVE STREAMING THE SHOWS

We plan to Live Stream both the Showmanship and Show for family members and friends to be able to watch from the comfort of their home. We are finalizing all the details and will share this information as soon as possible.

FOOD VENDORS ON-SITE DURING SHOW

We will have some food vendors available to purchase food and drinks for exhibitors during the show.

ARRIVAL DETAILS AND TICKETING INFORMATION

We are finalizing the Ticket and Entrance Procedures. We will need to monitor the number of people at the show so tickets will be issued.

Each swine exhibitor will receive twelve (12) daily admission passes. Exceptions will be made when more than one (1) exhibitor is from the same family.

The second exhibitor from the same family will be issued four (4) daily admission passes. The third exhibitor will be issued four (4) daily admission passes.
