This Policy describes how and why Nodeflux ("we", "us" or "our") uses cookies.

What Are Cookies?

As is common practice with almost all professional websites, this site uses cookies, which are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer or mobile device, to improve your experience and allow proper functioning of the site. This page describes what information we gather, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies. We will also share how you can prevent these cookies from being stored. However, this may downgrade or 'break' certain elements of the site's functionality.

How we Use Cookies

We use cookies for a variety of reasons detailed below to personalize your experience on our Sites, for instance, to make your future activities and experience on our site more efficient, to understand how people use our site, and to help us improve the structure and content of our Sites.

Unfortunately, in most cases there are no industry standard options for disabling cookies without completely disabling the functionality and features they add to this site. It is recommended that you leave all cookies if you are not sure whether you need them or not in case they are used to provide a service that you use.

The Cookies We Set

We use two types of cookies on our site: session cookies and persistent cookies. A session cookie is a temporary cookie that remains on your device until you leave our site. Session cookies are essential to make our site work correctly, as they enable you to move around our site and use our features. A persistent cookie remains on your device for much longer, or until you manually delete it (how long the cookie remains on your device will depend on the duration or "lifetime" of the specific cookie and your browser settings). Persistent cookies help us recognize you as a return user of our site so it's easier and convenient to return to and interact with our site. In addition, persistent cookies also help us recognize and record information about your web browsing habits during the lifetime of the persistent cookie. Our site uses the following types of cookies:

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies:** These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the site and use features of the site securely. Without these cookies, you may not be able to take full advantage of the features and functions of the website.
- **Performance Cookies:** These cookies collect information about how visitors use the site, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages.
- **Functionality Cookies:** These cookies are used to recognize you and remember your preferences or settings when you return to the site.
- **Social Media Cookies:** These cookies allow you to share what you've been doing on the website on social media such as Facebook. These cookies are not within our control. Interactions with these features are governed by the privacy policy of the company providing it.
- **Analytics Cookies:** We use different types of analytical cookies that allow us to provide you with more efficient and contextual support and that also provide us with data around your usage of the site that we may use to improve the site but also to benefit our business and the businesses of our affiliates, including with respect to business purposes unrelated to the site. For example, we use Google Analytics to monitor traffic levels, search queries and visits to our website. For more information about Google analytic cookies, please see Google's privacy policy.
