Essays for Ethics Fellowship Application. Each essay should be between 300-650 words.

The Essays should be clearly labeled in a single document.

It can be uploaded as a Word Document or as a PDF.

- 1. Your background. Let us know who you are, where you came from and how you got to where you are today.
- 2. Please describe the roots of your interest in ethics and the reasons why you want to participate in the fellowship program.
 - a. Include a description of the skills and information which you hope to acquire during the fellowship and how you will put them to use in your own clinical practice or within your organization at large.
- 3. Describe a medical ethics dilemma you have encountered in your work. Explain how you navigated the situation and what you learned from the encounter.
- 4. Please describe a project you can envision accomplishing in your nine-month fellowship. Additionally, please share time management strategies you intend to utilize in order to participate fully in fellowship responsibilities as described above.
 - a. Fellows will be required to participate in didactic seminars, share in ethics consultation responsibilities, and complete a scholarly project during their year of fellowship. This may be a research project, an "ethics quality improvement" project for his or her own clinical unit, or a creative project in ethics (e.g. collecting or writing narratives.)
