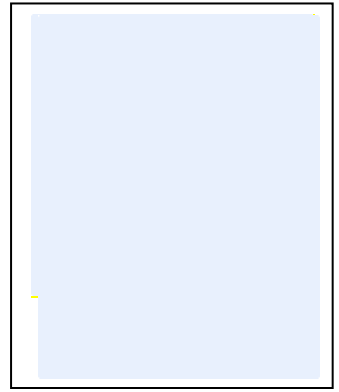


Los Barrios de Amarillo Scholarship Application

- Include one letter of recommendation
- GPA of 3.0 (80)
- Attach a 400 word essay (choose topic from second page)
- A copy of your high school transcript
- Plan to attend Amarillo College, West Texas A&M University, Clarendon College, Frank Phillips College, Eastern New Mexico and Texas Tech University.

Criteria for the following years will be

- GPA 2.5 (77 or above) for the previous year
- A copy of college transcript
- Actively enrolled each semester as full time student, 12 hours
- Must maintain regular contact within mentorship program (if unable to meet the requirements, please reach out to your mentor)
