Introduction

We take our Anti-Doping responsibilities very seriously and undertake a number of actions to ensure that we stay compliant with all UKAD requirements and create a fair and safe environment. An Anti-Doping statement is available on the Scottish Wrestling website and highlights the organisation's commitment to ensuring the best Anti-Doping practices.

Items

Anti Doping Policy and Processes	An up to date Anti-Doping policy with relevant processes is in place. This document is reviewed on an annual basis and modified as needed
BWA	SW works in partnership with BWA to coordinate Anti-Doping efforts and ensure that Anti-Doping regulations are adhered to in Scotland and UK wide
UKAD	SW works with UKAD to ensure that the organisation is up to date with all Anti-Doping requirements and receives the necessary expert advice
sportscotland	sportscotland supports and oversees compliance with Anti-Doping regulations and has made it part of the investment requirements for SGBs
Athlete Workshops	SW supported by sportscotland and UKAD has conducted several workshops with athletes and staff members throughout the year
Anti-Doping Officer	An Anti-Doping officer is appointed and works with all relevant partners to ensure compliance
Communication	Anti-Doping regulations and updates are communicated via the SW website and internal channels for clubs, athletes and board members
Board Statement	The board has a written commitment statement which is available on the website
UKAD Framework	SW is working closely with BWA and UKAD to be fully compliant with the new Assurance Framework. The new assurance framework became an investment requirement from sportscotland and a qualification requirement from Team Scotland for CG2022
