



PhD & Postdoc Mobility Program Application Form

Overview

The PhD and Postdoc mobility program is aimed at existing PhD students and postdocs in the ELLIS/ ELISE partner network who want to initiate a collaboration with a Fellow or Member at another site. To apply for a mobility grant, the following two conditions must be fulfilled:

- 1. You are doing a PhD/postdoc at one of the ELISE partner institutions (cf. 'ELISE Membership' infra) **OR** you are an ELLIS PhD student or postdoc (cf. 'ELLIS Membership' infra; http://ellis.eu/phd-postdoc).
- 2. The exchange is supported by two advisors in the ELLIS network: the advisor from the home institution, and the advisor from the host institution who will supervise the exchange. Both advisors must be Members of the ELLIS network (http://ellis.eu/members), and at least one of them an ELLIS Fellow/Scholar (http://ellis.eu/fellows) or Unit Faculty (http://ellis.eu/units).
