4orMore Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do the friends I refer to 4orMore have to be South Asians?

Α

No. They don't have to be South Asians, but they must be Democrats or Democratic-leaning. Please note that the tool and associated website has content designed for South Asians, but non-South Asians are welcome to participate.

Q: Do the friends I refer to 4orMore have to be Democrats?

Α

Yes, we are focusing on enrolling those who support the election of Democratic candidates (not necessarily registered Democrats only).

Q: Can my friends be from multiple states?

A:

Each time you invite a friend, you must indicate his/her state. You will receive a unique message to forward to that friend. You repeat this process for each friend.

Q: Does every new enrollee require training?

A:

This web site has many tools including how to videos and other documents. Of course, please email us if you need additional information or help.

Q: Why does 4orMore get into my voting process?

A:

4orMore has two main functions:

- Help make sure Your Vote is Counted
- Help you Amplify Your Vote

When you enroll, you immediately enter the process of making sure your Vote is counted before taking you to the main menu.

Q: What happens to the private information once the election is over?

A:

We will purge all private information contained in 4orMore as soon as it is deactivated unless there is a good reason for 4orMore to remain an active campaign.

Q: How do I make sure people I invited have enrolled?

A:

Send S for 'Your 4orMore Status" to find out which of the friends you invited have enrolled.

Q: All the people we are enrolling are strong Democrats or leaning Democratic and are all planning to vote and also have the information they need for voting. So, how is this tool helping them?

A:

We want to get Democrats and Democratic leaning independents who are ambivalent and standing on the sidelines to vote. With a foundation of strong Democrats, 4orMore will grow to reach all South Asians.

Q: I can see the enrollment message from my friend. But I am not able to tap on the link in it. A:
