Participant Criteria

People who live in Japan that are the primary shoppers / decision makers for what to eat in their households, People who live in Japan that enjoy & eat fast food

Research Methods

• A <u>survey</u> created with Typeform - 11 participants

Online Ordering

- **45**% of participants (or 5 out of the 11 people that took the quiz) said they did not order food online
- **64**% **of participants** (or 7 out of the 11 people that took the quiz) said **they prefer ordering food in-person** rather than online
