The Snail and the Whale - Chicago Premiere



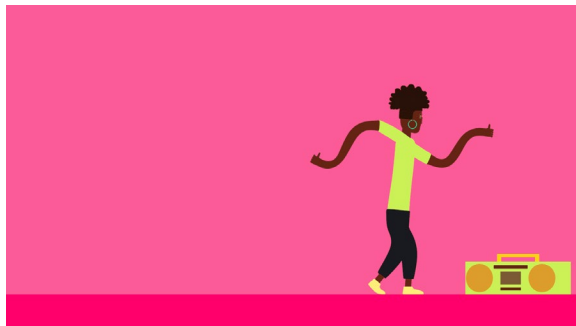

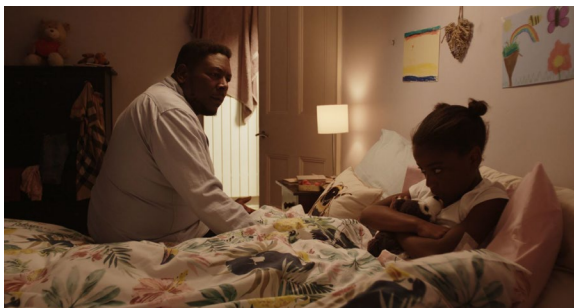
