extending safety supports, perforated tear-away window, hook and loop fastener, absorbant pad, leak-proof backing, moisture-retention interior, odor control, moisture-wicking, >1000cc absorption, 300 lb weight limit, better

visibility

for care, breathable material, no bunching or lumping, gentle on skin, saves time and money, prevents injury, reduces litigation exposure, allows for hands-free cares, patented, latex-free, disposable, etc.
