You will operate a remote operations center flying several agricultural fields per week, working closely with farmers and technical engineers alike. The data you collect will be fed into TerraClear's artificial intelligence image processing pipeline to produce accurate rock maps for customers.

- Operate TerraClear fleet drones to produce rocks maps for farm customers.
