



- 1 **6. PLEASE PRINT SCORE CARDS SO THEY ARE LEGIBLE:** If you are entered in  
2 sweepstakes, your card may be thrown out if not legible. Handicapper will not post cards that  
3 are not legible.
- 4 7. If you sign up for a tournament (ladies or mixed), please be at least 15 minutes early.
- 5 8. Hole out all putts.

### **18 AND 9-HOLE PLAY**

- 7 1. Any new member or 9-Hole golfer may request a three (3) month provisional handicap (18  
8 holes), if she does not already have one. During this period (suggested Oct. – Dec. to avoid  
9 extra fees) she may play in the 9-Hole and 18-Hole sweepstakes. The 9-Hole golfer will not  
10 be eligible for the 18-Hole “Awards” for the 3 month period. She will remain in contention  
11 for the 9-Hole “Awards” until she decides, at the end of 3 months, which group she wishes to  
12 play with. At that time, her handicap will be listed with the group she chooses.
- 13 2. In regards to annual trophies, the above mentioned golfer relinquishes her eligibility to  
14 compete in the group in which she has forfeited play.
- 15 3. Sweepstakes: Competition play must include two players in the same group (two 18-Hole  
16 players or two 9-Hole players). Players are not eligible for sweeps if not signed up with  
17 competition group play.
- 18 4. Tuesday and Thursday Play: The 9-Hole golfers have priority on Tuesday mornings from  
19 scheduled Tee-off times until 10:00 am. The 18-Hole golfers have priority on Thursday  
20 mornings from scheduled Tee-off times until 10:00 am. However, any lady golfer is allowed  
21 to play on Tuesday and Thursday mornings as long as her group does not interfere with the  
22 group playing in competition. These ladies must obtain permission from the Pro before teeing  
23 off. There are exceptions when either the 9-Hole group or the 18-Hole group is having  
24 invitational or club championship play. These events will be posted in advance.

### **U.S.G.A. RECOMMENDATION – HANDICAPS**

27 The game of golf consists of 18 holes of play and there is no such thing as an index over 40.4  
28 for 18 holes. (A maximum handicap of 39 is required to join the Oakdale 18-Hole ladies golfers.)

### **MEMBERSHIP**

31 Any new member who wishes to join the Oakdale Women’s Golf Club 18-Hole Group must  
32 have a local handicap of not more than 39 based on the current GHIN Slope for a minimum of  
33 three consecutive months. Any 9-Hole player who wishes to join the 18-Hole Group must have  
34 an established 9-hole handicap of 19 or less for a minimum of 3 consecutive months.

35 The Handicap Chairman shall serve as the membership chairman and check the eligibility of  
36 all new members.

### **MONTHLY BRIDGE**

1 OLGA sponsors a bridge session for all the ladies of Oakdale Golf and Country Club on the  
2 last Friday of each month (unless otherwise designated) from 9 am to noon. Refreshments are  
3 served and prizes are awarded.

4 Reservations or cancellations will not be accepted later than Wednesday at noon preceding  
5 the Friday play. The fee to play will be as agreed upon and established by the committee.  
6 Anyone who has not made reservations WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO PLAY.

7 Members should sign up with a partner. A member may have a guest as a partner. If after the  
8 deadline you find you are unable to play, you are responsible to replace the twosome. To avoid  
9 problems, check with your playing partner before Wednesday noon.

1 **BY-LAWS OF THE OAKDALE LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION**

2  
3 **ARTICLE I – NAME AND LOGO**

4 The name of the organization shall be the OAKDALE LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION –  
5 (OLGA). The term “Board” as used in these By-Laws means the Board of Directors. The Oak  
6 tree shall represent the Association logo.

7 **ARTICLE II – PURPOSES**

8 The purposes of OLGA shall be: (1) to promote the interest of golf and social activities for the  
9 women members of the Oakdale Golf and Country Club; (2) to afford a convenient and  
10 authoritative means of arranging dates for calendar events as are allowed or permitted under the  
11 By-Laws of the Oakdale Golf and Country Club (OGCC). If in conflict, the OLGA By-Laws  
12 shall not supersede the aforementioned OGCC. By-Laws.

13 **ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP**

14 Every female with membership privileges of the Oakdale Golf and Country Club, 21 years of age  
15 or over, or spouse of member, shall be eligible to join OLGA. Unmarried daughters between the  
16 ages of 18 and 21 shall also be eligible to join OLGA, and shall have all rights and privileges as  
17 prescribed in the OGCC By-Laws, ARTICLE IV, MEMBERSHIP, Section 7.

18 A junior golfer between the age of 14 to 17 whose mother is a member of OLGA is eligible to  
19 participate in sweeps on regular play days during school vacations if they have a valid WGANC  
20 handicap.

21 **ARTICLE IV – DUES**

22 Dues of OLGA shall be \$10.00 per year and will be billed in the October Oakdale Golf and  
23 Country Club monthly statement. The funds will be forwarded to the OLGA Treasurer within 30  
24 days of the billing.

25 **ARTICLE V – MEETINGS**

26 General Meetings for members will be held as deemed necessary by the board, giving a  
27 minimum two week notice to the membership.

28 Section 1. The Annual Meeting will be held in conjunction with the December Champagne  
29 Luncheon and installation of incoming officers. This meeting date will be designated by the  
30 Social Committee Chairperson.

31 Section 2. The President of OLGA may call special meetings when necessary.

1 a resume of resolutions and actions taken by OLGA to become a part of the official records of  
2 OLGA and to be used as a source of reference.

3 Section 4. **Treasurer** shall: (1) receive all dues of OLGA; (2) be responsible for the deposit of  
4 all money received, whether from dues of other sources, in the proper bank account; (3) maintain  
5 proper records of the bank account; (4) maintain records of debts of OLGA and pay debts upon  
6 approval by the Board; (5) prepare and submit a report of OLGA finances at all regular board  
7 meetings; (6) leave her records and check book with the President when she is unable to attend  
8 meetings; (7) during term of office be a member of the OLGA Budget Committee and the  
9 following year shall chair that committee; (8) prepare a resume of income and expenses during  
10 her term of office.

11 Section 5. **Ways and Means Chairperson** shall: (1) plan events that will be money-making  
12 affairs to meet club expenses; (2) appoint a Telephone Committee Chairperson; (3) appoint other  
13 committees as necessary; (4) be a member of the OLGA Budget Committee.

14 Section 6. **Social Committee Chairperson** shall: (1) be responsible for all social activities for  
15 the calendar year; (2) appoint a Hospitality Committee, a Bridge Chairperson, and other  
16 committees to foster good social relations among the members; (3) notify members as to dates  
17 and conditions pertaining to social activities; (4) be a member of the OLGA Budget Committee;  
18 (5) endeavor to promote regular social events as listed in Article XIII.

19 Section 7. **Membership Chairperson** shall: (1) send out membership information letters to  
20 new female members of OGCC; (2) maintain an up-to-date mailing list of OLGA members; (3)  
21 give names of new OLGA members to the Handicap Chairpersons of the 18-hole and 9-hole  
22 ladies groups; (4) provide names of new Oakdale Golf and Country Club members to Telephone  
23 Committee as necessary; (5) be a member of the OLGA Budget Committee.

24 Section 8. **Captain of 18-Hole Golf**, elected by said group, shall: (1) direct affairs of the 18-  
25 Hole golfers; (2) appoint a Handicap Chairperson, a Tournament Chairperson, and other  
26 committees to further the activities of the 18-Hole golfers; (3) be an ex-officio member of all  
27 committees appointed by her; (4) be responsible for the arrangement of all local golf events and  
28 notify members as to the dates and conditions pertaining to these events; (5) promote  
29 participation in events sponsored by the Women's Golf Association of Northern California  
30 (WGANC) and notify members as to dates and conditions pertaining to these events; (6) prepare  
31 a monthly report to members which will be published in the Oakdale Golf and Country Club  
32 *TEE TALK*.

33 Section 9. **Captain of 9-Hole Golf** shall be elected by said group. She shall: (1) direct affairs  
34 of the 9-Hole golfers; (2) appoint a Handicap Chairperson, a Tournament Chairperson, and other  
35 committees necessary to further the activities of the 9-Hole golfers; (3) be an exofficio member  
36 of all committees appointed by her; (4) be responsible for the arrangement of all local golf events  
37 and notify members as to the dates and conditions pertaining to these events; (5) promote  
38 participation in events sponsored by the Women's Golf Association of Northern California  
39 (WNHGA) and notify members as to dates and conditions pertaining to these events; (6) prepare  
40 a monthly report to members which will be published in the Oakdale Golf and Country Club  
41 *TEE TALK*.

1 **ARTICLE IX – COMMITTEES**

2 Section 1. **Parliamentarian** shall act as advisor to the Board of members concerning rules and  
3 uses of the By-Laws.

4 Section 2. **Historian** shall maintain a scrap book with clippings and pictures of OLGA activities  
5 to be presented to the President at the end of the year.

6 Section 3. **Nominating Committee**. The President shall appoint a Nominating Committee in  
7 September to consist of the immediate past president, and four other members representing the 9-  
8 Hole, 18-Hole, and social groups.

9 This committee shall select and present to the OLGA Board the names for the elective officers of  
10 President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Ways and Means Chairperson, Social Committee  
11 Chairperson, and Membership Chairperson.

12 Section 4. **Auditor** shall audit the Treasurer’s books before a new term begins. A special audit  
13 for an unexpired term will be made. This person will be solicited to conduct the audit and will  
14 be independent of the OLGA board.

15 Section 5. **Telephone Committee** will telephone members when requested by the Board, Social  
16 Chairperson, or Ways and Means Chairperson.

17 Section 6. **Sunshine Committee** shall send members cards in case of illness, injury, or death in  
18 the family.

19 Section 7. **OLGA Budget Committee** shall be formed for the new year chaired by the  
20 previous year’s Treasurer. Members are to include the Vice President, past and incoming  
21 chairpersons of Ways and Means, Social Committee, Membership Committee and incoming  
22 President and Treasurer. The purpose shall be to formulate a budget for the following year.

23  
24 **ARTICLE X – HANDICAPS**

25 Every golfing member of OLGA must maintain a handicap in order to compete in OLGA golfing  
26 tournaments.

27 To participate in weekly sweepstakes play, all entrants must be members of OLGA. After  
28 payment of entry fee for sweepstakes play there can be no refund or return of money.

29 A handicap requires five (5) signed and dated scores in the hands of the handicapper within a  
30 three month period; an established handicap, twenty (20) signed and dated scores. This also  
31 applies to all new members.  
32

33 **ARTICLE XI – GOLF TOURNAMENTS**

34 Section 1. Tuesday shall be weekly tournament day for 9-Hole golf play. Thursday shall be  
35 weekly tournament day for 18-Hole golf play.



1 Section 2. Type of Tournament. The monthly bulletin shall be posted on the bulletin board each  
2 month, designating the type of tournament for Tuesday and Thursday play and any other special  
3 events planned by the Tournament Chairmen and their committees.

4 Section 3. Distribution of awards. Suggestions of the Tournament Committees of the 18 and 9  
5 Hole groups will be the basis for distribution. All decisions will be made by the Chairperson or  
6 the Committee in charge.

7 Section 4. Championship Tournament and a Handicap Tournament will be played each year.  
8 The Tournaments will take place in the Spring and Fall, and all the entrants for each round of  
9 play shall compete on the day officially designated for the play of that particular round.

10 Rules governing these tournaments will be posted two weeks prior to the event.

11 An entry fee may be required if determined necessary by the Captain and her committee.

12 Five score cards must be posted within a three month period before the tournament and having  
13 been played with and attested by a member of OLGA.

14  
15 **ARTICLE XII – GUEST DAY**

16 Each member is entitled to invite 1 non-member guest or 1, 2, or 3 member guests on Guest Day;  
17 18-Hole golfers, the fourth Thursday of each month; 9-Hole golfers, the fourth Tuesday of each  
18 month or as scheduled and posted by the respective golf groups.

19  
20 **ARTICLE XIII – SOCIAL**

21 All ladies of OGCC and their guests are eligible to participate in social events sponsored by  
22 OLGA, unless specified to the contrary.

23 Regular social events will include: (1) monthly card party; (2) Spring and Fall table-game  
24 luncheons; (3) December Champagne Luncheon, and other events as the Board desires.

25 The December Champagne Luncheon will be for OLGA members and the guests of members.  
26

27 **ARTICLE XIV – AMENDMENTS**

28 Amendments to these By-Laws may be made by a majority vote at the Annual Meeting (or a  
29 special meeting called by the President) at which a quorum is present. Written notice of the  
30 proposed amendment to be considered shall be posted in the Women’s locker room 30 days prior  
31 to the meeting. All amendments must thereafter be attached and become a part of these By-Laws.
