Project idea

The idea is to create an activity that would be fun for the teens and serve them by bringing them together. You can launch the project on zoom and tell the kids they will receive a letter through the post with all the information they need to participate. (Tell the parents about the project but no specifics). The letter will contain the challenges and information about how they can upload their videos.

Not all the videos will be used so you've got to make your video spectacular, to ensure that you make the cut!

Just so you know the videos you submit won't be posted on the Church website or YouTube or any kind of social media, it will just be for you and your family to enjoy. We will send you a link to the finished video when everything is complete.
