



## WBF Amateur Masters Division (AMD)

### Promoters Requirements

All Promoters hosting WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters contests MUST adhere to the following requirements and conditions;

- Promoters must possess a current Promoters license/accreditation and be registered with their local Boxing Commission and abide by the governance of that license/registration
- Promoters must ensure that all safety requirements are adhered to according to the rules and regulations, policy and legislation of the local boxing commission
- Promoters are to ensure that a registered Medical Practitioner is present and in attendance for all WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters contests to conduct both pre and post contest medical and fitness assessments for all combatants.
- Promoters must ensure that when matching Masters Boxers that WBF requirements are adhered to (as per Combatant Criteria)
- Promoters are to ensure that all Officials (judges and referees) appointed to officiate WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters contests are currently registered / licensed with the local Boxing Commission
- Promoters are to ensure that all combatants contesting WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters contests have current Medical fitness and Serological clearance Certificates prior to match making

- Promoters must provide a suitable and safe venue when hosting WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters contests
  - Promoters must represent the WBF in a professional and positive manner at all times when hosting WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters contests
  - Promoters must provide the WBF with adequate notice (30 days) of their intent to host WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters contests
  - Promoters must ensure that all WBF Sanction fee invoices/accounts are paid in full (21 days) prior to hosting WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters contests
  - Promoters are to read, understand, acknowledge and unequivocally agree to the WBF Legal Indemnity Document provided by the WBF Representative
  - Promoters must sign the WBF Legal Indemnity Document and also submit a legal and current Public Liability Certificate of Insurance covering injury or death to all combatants contesting WBF sanctioned Amateur Masters Championships prior to sanction approval by the WBF
