TEXT: Psalm 42:1-5

- 1) God doesn't guess what is about to happen, nor is He ever surprised by life's events. He makes promises through His word and He has the authority to fulfill every one of them. We believe His promises with a confident expectation! **Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:22-23**

- 2) Christian communion reminds us to expect and anticipate the second coming of Christ to our world. **1 Corinthians 11:23-26, Matthew 26:26-29** Biblical hope anticipates that God's word will come to pass. **Psalm 130:5-8**

- 3) Because biblical hope does not come naturally for us, we must speak encouragement to ourselves passionately and often as did the psalmist David when he said "Why so downcast oh my soul, hope in God" **Psalm 42:5; Romans 15:13**

Let's Go: Psalm 119:81

- Lights can be symbols of hope! Let us pray that God would use us to show forth His light in the darkness of our world.
- Let's place candles in our windows nightly to remind ourselves and others that Jesus is still the light of the world and our only hope!
