Jefferson County Conservation District (JCCD) is a non-regulatory sub-division of state government created in 1946. JCCD provides information and technical and financial assistance to help all Jefferson County residents meet sustainable, land-use goals. Conservation districts are nationwide, grassroots conservation agencies governed by a local Board of Supervisors. The Conservation Planner/Resource Specialist is responsible for managing contracts, installation of riparian forest buffers, geospatial analysis and mapping, and other conservation practices related to agriculture, water and nutrient management, fish passage, and habitat restoration.
