Youth Education Coordinator

Terms: Regular, full-time position

Position Description:

The person in this position will be an inspiring and respectful mentor; provide high quality youth environmental education; coordinate meaningful outdoor activities; develop a learning climate that provides for student motivation and engagement; develop curriculum to meet and exceed standards; complete course assessment activities, documentation, and reporting; participate in regional and statewide conservation district education initiatives; and promote partnerships and stewardship opportunities among school districts, educators, partners, and jurisdictions. This position is supervised by the Communications Program Manager.

Required Qualifications:

- Teaching certificate and/or 2+ years youth education experience in the classroom and outdoors
- Practical hands-on experience with applied learning techniques in one or more of the following topics: watersheds, water quality testing, natural resources conservation, agriculture, stormwater pollution and/or stormwater management.
- Bachelor degree in an environmental or education related field
- Experience managing projects and/or programs
- Valid WA State Driver's License
- Ability to pass a background check, and any other tests required by schools.
- Knowledge and experience developing, presenting, and evaluating curriculum.
- Ability to work effectively with students K – 12th grade.
- Ability to communicate effectively
- Recognition and appreciation of the diversity of needs and interests of youth learners
