Introduction

The convergence of the coronavirus pandemic and the annual flu season this autumn and winter has public-health officials on edge. This is referred to as "Twindemic"

What does "twindemic" mean?

Twindemic refers to the dual threat of a severe flu outbreak on top of the COVID-19 pandemic in the fall and winter of 2020.

This could potentially overwhelm hospitals, straining resources and health-care workers' time.

Similarities between COVID 19 and Flu

Both COVID 19 and Flu cause respiratory disease, which presents as a wide range of illnesses from asymptomatic or mild through to severe disease and death.

Secondly, both viruses are transmitted by contact, droplets, and fomites. As a result, the same public health measures, such as hand hygiene and good respiratory etiquette (coughing into your elbow or a tissue and immediately disposing of the tissue) and keeping your distance from others are important actions all can take to prevent infection.
