Chiniki and Bears paw Nations have raised important issues many of which we have been dealing with for a long time as you are aware. Going forward, we believe a number of these issues could be resolved at the Canada Recognition of Indigenous Rights and Self-Determination Discussion Table for which we have received contribution funding for.
