The North County African American Women's Association (NCAAWA) is a non-profit, 501 © (3), volunteer organization located in North San Diego County. The organization was formed to celebrate ethnic and racial pride and to explore the beauty and strength of our culture. The Association grew out of a need to provide mentors for women who were participants in the SOLO Project, part of the Carl Perkins 1990 Vocational Education Act. Our organization has grown in its vision by holding Women's Conferences for teens and adults, community activities, and by offering achievement awards and scholarships to students wishing to further their education at a four-year college, community college, trade, technical or graduate school.

Title of Award:

The North County African American Women's Association Scholarship

Level of education for which Scholarship is granted:

Four-Year College, Community College, Regional Occupation Program (ROP), or Trade and Technical Schools, and Graduate Students enrolled in a degree or certificate program.

Amount of Scholarship:

Amounts vary from year to year.

Eligibility Requirement:

1. Must be a female of African American **descent, graduating high school senior, ROP**, trade school or adult student, including graduate student in a degree or certificate program.
2. Must **reside in or attend school in the following locations: Carlsbad, Escondido, Fallbrook, Oceanside, San Dieguito, San Marcos, Vista**
3. Must have C average or above and good citizenship.
4. Must be enrolled with a **minimum of 12 units** in a college, ROP, trade or technical school for the entering semester.
5. Must submit a completed application, resume, official transcript and two letters of recommendation from teachers, ministers, employers, or community organizations. Official transcript must be in an officially sealed envelope or sent directly from a counselor.
6. A photo **must be submitted** with the initial application package **to be used** for publicity purposes.

Application Period:

January 1 to April 30

Deadline for Receipt:

Completed application packet must be postmarked no later than April 30 to be considered. Please send **completed** application to above address. Full application packet is available on line at www.ncaawa.org.

Method of Disbursement:

Winner must present confirmation of enrollment at a four-year college, community college, trade/technical school, or ROP to receive their scholarship. Confirmation of enrollment must be received by SEPTEMBER 30. Winner forfeits award if the deadline is not met. PLEASE NOTE: Scholarships will be mailed to awardees within 10 days of receipt of enrollment confirmation.

DATES TO REMEMBER:

November – Scholarship applications released

January 1 to April 30 – Open application period

May to June - Winners notified by mail and/or announced at an Awards Program.

September 30 – Deadline for award recipient to confirm enrollment and financial awards are mailed to recipients upon receipt of confirmation.
