


3 points



# Morning

Each event in the morning will be worth a total of 3 points to the halls. The hall with the superior average of times/placements (or totaled times/placements) will be given the the 3 points. Together, all 6 events can give **18** points

3 points



# Afternoon

Each event in the morning will be worth a total of 3 points to the halls. The hall with the superior average of times/placements (or totaled times/placements) will be given the the 3 points. Together, all 6 events can give **18** points

Each Quarter is to be granted 15 points per. To that total is added Filed day totals.

Score going into field day  
Q1,3,4 (45 points-NH) Q2 (15 points-AH)

**4 Flex points** can be allocated as Field Day officials (corroborated by the Warden) see fit

Together, **36** points are available

**Total= 40**
