

## ESD Changemakers tier 1 & 2 support offerings

We are offering two levels of membership. Tier 1 will require the institution and students union to take more of a leadership role in supporting students and staff on their co-creation journey as part of the ESD changemakers programme, whilst tier 2 membership offers more support and input from SOS-UK. A breakdown of the difference in support across the two levels of membership can be found below.

<b>Recruitment support:</b> SOS-UK to support the institution to recruit students from across the academic schools/faculties of the institution, through provision of communications materials and reaching out to the SU/ relevant departments and student societies. Shortlisting to be led by the institution.	✓	✓
<b>Pre-launch staff introduction:</b> SOS-UK to provide an introductory & planning session for institution staff (academic and operational) to support their engagement and participation with ESD changemakers. This is aimed to support with academic staff recruitment for participation.		✓
<b>Guidance on how best to support your student changemakers:</b> Good practice guidance briefing webinar.	✓	✓
<b>Launch event:</b> For students and staff across the national network, introducing the programme, sharing learning from existing models and examples of embedding ESD in curricula, networking opportunity for students and staff.	✓	✓
<b>Planning and preparatory workshops:</b> Primarily for students, staff welcome to join, supporting them to make realistic action plans, with robust approaches for co-creating curricula transformation.	✓	✓
<b>National network progress review:</b> 1-day conference bringing together ESD changemakers (students & staff). An opportunity to share progress, updates, challenges and learn from each other.	✓	✓
<b>Closing conference:</b> Celebration of progress made and lessons learned. Students and staff to co-present the learnings, outcomes and outputs of their co-creation approach to curricula transformation for sustainability.	✓	✓
