SMART METERS – MICROGRANTS 2021

Terms and Conditions

- Applications for microgrants are to be submitted via the [online form](#).
- Applications for microgrants close at midday on 19th November 2021, all applications will then be reviewed, and successful applications selected to cover a range of activities.
- Applicants will receive feedback on the outcome of their application within one week of submission (26th November 2021). If successful, your activity will need to be completed and proof submitted to SOS-UK by 23.59 on 9th December 2021.
- Application forms should detail the planned activity and timeframe. You can apply to undertake more than one activity as part of your application.
- We expect all activities to take no longer than 1-2 hours to complete.
- On full completion of the activity payment will be made into a UK bank account.
- Payment will be offered at £25 per confirmed activity and a maximum payment of £50 per person is available.
- Do not pay for any expenses related to your activity out of your own finances, prior to having been informed of the success of your submission as this will not be eligible to be reclaimed. If funding is required for expenses these should be communicated and pre-agreed in advance of any activity taking place.
- Payment will not be provided for part completion of any activity, unless proven extenuating circumstances has resulted in the activity not being completed.
- Please keep in regular communication with your assigned SOS-UK contact who is available to support you and your planned activity.
- Access to Smart Energy GB and SOS-UK logos and branding will be provided by your contact where applicable.
- Payment will not be provided for any activity that involves the consumption of alcohol.
- Please always ensure that any activity follows university and college guidelines, including social distancing. SOS-UK will not be responsible in cases where these rules have not been followed.
- By completing an activity, you agree to this being published by Smart Energy GB and SOS-UK.

Suggested Activities

- Creating short videos or GIFs of your top sustainability tips including the use of smart meters; create approx. 3x 20 second videos or 1x 1 minute video.
- Creating a video about your experience of getting and using a smart meter and being sustainable whilst private renting at university or college; approx. 1 minute video which may include for example what you have learned, benefited or why you got involved.

- Creating a set of graphics or animations communicating top sustainability tips in your home including the use of smart meters; approx. 3-5 graphics for social media or communication materials.
- Writing a blog, article or case study on your experience getting and/or using a smart meter or on being sustainable whilst private renting at university or college; approx. 4-500 words and relevant photo.
- Organising a virtual sustainability themed quiz, event or watch party aimed at engaging people at your university on smart meters and sustainability.
