Practical Assessment – Perform CPR for 2 minutes on an adult manikin

D	 <p>Check for Danger</p> <p>Make sure it is safe for you, the casualty and bystanders.</p>		
R	 <p>Check for a Response</p> <p>Use a talk and touch technique to check for a response. Talk: "Can you hear me?", "Open your eyes". Touch: squeeze shoulders firmly</p>		
S	 <p>Call 000 Send for help</p> <p>Shout for help or send someone to call Triple Zero (000). If required, send for help at the earliest possible stage.</p>		
A	 <p>Open the Airway</p> <p>Use the head tilt and chin lift technique to open the airway. If blocked, turn the casualty onto their side and clear their airway.</p>		
B	 <p>Check for Breathing</p> <p>Look, listen and feel for normal breathing. If not breathing or not breathing normally, commence CPR.</p>		
C	 <p>Commence CPR</p> <p>30:2</p> <p>Give 30 compressions followed by 2 rescue breaths. If unable or unwilling to give rescue breaths, give compression only CPR.</p>		
D	 <p>Attach a Defibrillator (AED*)</p> <p>Attach an AED* as soon as available and follow the prompts. *AED: Automated External Defibrillator</p>
