# Memorial Day – 2022 – Do Not Forget

## Deuteronomy 8:11-19

Memorial Day was created to help remember the high cost of fighting for freedom. Unfortunately, a **lot of people don't remember**, which really should not be surprising since many people also forget about God and what He has done. Throughout the Bible, God constantly was encouraging His people not to forget what He had done and would continue to do. We can learn from the words of Moses as we apply what he said in Deuteronomy 8 to our lives right now, in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

- I. Do not forget God by not keeping His commandments! – Deuteronomy 8:11
  - A. Far too often, we begin to take our physical blessings for granted and gradually, we are lead away from the very God who gave them! – Deuteronomy 8:12-14
  - B. We begin trusting **our temporary goodies so much that we feel that we don't need to follow all of God's commands.**
- II. Do not forget what God has done for you! – Deuteronomy 8:15-16
  - A. **God's purposes (even the tests and trials) are** always for our eventual good. – Romans 8:28
  - B. We may often mouth a **"thanks"** to God but in reality actually believe that our prosperity is a result of our own goodness, strength, and power. – Deuteronomy 8:17-18; Proverbs 10:22a; 1 Corinthians 15:10a
- III. Do not forget **God's role in giving** us our freedoms! – Psalm 33:12a
  - A. The greatness of any nation rests in its righteousness and justice. – Proverbs 14:34
  - B. Hearts become proud and sin becomes rampant when God is forgotten. – Galatians 6:7

God tells us, in the very last verse of our text (Deuteronomy 8:19), **"And it shall come about, if you ever forget the Lord your God and follow other gods and serve and worship them, I testify against you today that you will certainly perish."** Can I remind you that God knows that we sometimes forget Him. But He is here – always! He will never leave us or forsake us! Have you given your life to Him?
