

How to Record a Gig Room

We will release our own (incredibly cool) recording feature soon. In the meantime, here are instructions for recording your Gig Room with software that is already on your computer.

Using a Mac

- After opening your Gig Room, Open Quicktime
- In the QuickTime Player app on your Mac, choose File > New Screen Recording to open Screenshot and display the tools.
- Click the down arrow next to the Record button and choose internal microphone.
- Click the record button and follow the prompt to click the screen in order to record Full Screen.
- Click your browser icon to return to your Gig Room.
- To end recording, click the circle in the top navigation bar, to the left of the Wifi and Bluetooth icons.
- Name and save your Gig Room recording.

Using Windows

- After opening your Gig Room, open the start menu and search for “Game bar”, or press the Windows key and G simultaneously.
- The Game bar will appear along with the “Game capturing” caption.
- Press the Record button, or you can press the Windows key + Alt + R at the same time to start recording. (If you see a message informing you that screen recording is not available because gaming features have not been enabled, tuck the box in the window that appears and recording will start.)
- Click your browser icon to return to your Gig Room.
- Recordings are automatically saved as MP4 files in the Videos>Captures subfolder of your User folder. You can also access the recordings via the Game bar.
- Name and save your Gig Room recording.
