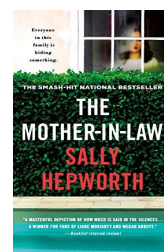
Book Groups

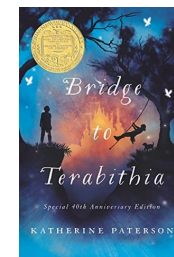
