| Surcharge Name and Amount | Reasons (Effective Jan.4th, 2021) |
|--|---|
| <p style="text-align: center;">Additional Handling</p> <p>\$16 per package (dimension) \$25.5 per package (weight) \$14 per package (packaging)</p> | <p>FedEx Ground/Home:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Measures greater than <u>48 inches</u> along its longest side; 2. Measures greater than <u>30 inches</u> along its second-longest side; 3. Any package measuring more than <u>105 inches</u> in length and girth (H×2+W×2) combined (<i>2021 New Rule</i>). 4. Actual weight is greater than <u>50 lbs.</u>(US Express and US Ground Service); 5. Actual weight is greater than <u>70 lbs.</u>(International Express and International Ground Service); 6. Package is not fully encased in an outer shipping container; 7. Package is encased in an outer shipping container not made of corrugated fiberboard(cardboard) materials, including but not limited to metal, wood, canvas, leather, hard plastic, soft plastic (e.g., plastic bags) or expanded polystyrene foam (e.g., Styrofoam); 8. Package is encased in an outer shipping container in shrink wrap or stretch wrap 9. Package is encased in a soft-sided pack (e.g., courier packs, poly bags and bubble mailers) that exceeds 18 inches along its longest side or <u>13 inches</u> along its second- longest side or <u>5 inches</u> in height; 10. Package is cylindrical, including (without limitation) mailing tubes, cans, buckets, barrels, drums or pails; 11. Package is bound with metal, plastic or cloth banding, or has wheels, casters, handles, or straps (including packages where the outer surface area is loosely wrapped, or where the contents protrude outside the surface area); 12. Package could become entangled in or cause damage to other packages or the FedEx sortation system; 13. AHS surcharge applies to every individual package. For example, if there are two cases bonded together, two separate AHS fees will apply. |

| <p>Address Correction</p> <p>\$18 per package</p> | <p>Applies to incomplete, incorrect or P.O. box recipient address. FedEx may attempt to determine the correct address, complete delivery and notify the shipper of the address correction.</p> |
| <p>Oversize Charge</p> <p>- FedEx Ground \$105</p> <p>- Home Delivery \$130</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.Any package measuring more than <u>96 inches</u> in length; 2.Any package measuring more than <u>130 inches</u> in length and girth (H×2+W×2) combined; 3.Rating will be based on the package's actual rounded weight or dimensional weight, subject to a <u>90 lbs</u> minimum billable weight. |
| <p>Ground Unauthorized Package Charge</p> <p>\$920 per package</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.Any package measuring more than <u>108 inches</u> in length; 2.Any package measuring more than <u>165 inches</u> in length and girth (H×2+W×2) combined; 3.Any package weighting more than <u>150 lbs.</u> |
| <p>Residential Surcharge</p> <p>\$4.8 per package</p> | <p>Applies when delivering to a residential area or non-business area. (If you check the box for residential at ShipSaving platform, the listed price will automatically include this fee)</p> |
| <p>Delivery Area Surcharge</p> <p>\$4 - \$10 per package</p> | <p>Delivery area surcharge applies to FedEx Express and FedEx Ground shipments destined for areas in Alaska and Hawaii or else, that are remote, sparsely populated or geographically difficult to access. Even California or New York zip codes might cause this surcharge.</p> |
| <p>Pick Up Fee</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Usually <u>\$2-\$4</u> per package, Saturday pickups charge <u>\$20</u> extra; 2. Weekly: <u>\$16.50</u> per week (invoiced weekly shipping charges of \$75 or more); 3. Weekly: <u>\$33</u> per week (invoiced weekly shipping charges of less than \$75) |
| <p>Peak Surcharges</p> | <p>*Visit fedex.com/peak-surcharges for information on peak surcharges in effect, including applicable services, surcharge amounts and effective dates.</p> |

| <p style="text-align: center;">Smartpost Delivery Surcharge</p> <p style="text-align: center;">\$2.35 U.S. Domestic \$2.95 U.S. Remote Area and Islands</p> | <p>Depending on the zip code of shipment destination, this surcharge applies when delivering packages to areas that are remote, sparsely populated or geographically difficult to access.</p> |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Smartpost Non- Machinable Surcharge</p> <p style="text-align: center;">- \$3.40 per package</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Any side of the package measuring more than <u>27 inches</u>; 2. Any one of the other two sides measuring more than <u>17 inches</u>; 3. Package weight measuring more than <u>35 lbs</u> 4. Cylinder package shape |

| <p>Additional Handling</p> <p>\$16 per package (dimension)</p> <p>\$25.5 per package (weight)</p> <p>\$15.25 per package (packaging)</p> | <p>Additional Handling Fee (AHS) will be applied when a package doesn't meet UPS qualifications. Actual charges will be determined by UPS distribution centers and their measurements.</p> <p>Possible reasons for this charge include but are not limited to the following:</p> <p><u>Weight</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any package weighing more than <u>50 lbs</u> (domestic) Any package weighing more than <u>70 lbs</u> (International) <p><u>Dimension</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any package measuring more than <u>48 inches</u> along its longest side Any package measuring over <u>30 inches</u> along its second-longest side Any package measuring more than <u>105 inches</u> in length and girth (H×2+W×2) combined (<u>2021 New Rule</u>). <p><u>Packaging</u></p> <p>Any package is encased in an outer shipping container not made of corrugated fiberboard(cardboard) materials, including but not limited to metal, wood, canvas, leather, hard plastic, soft plastic (e.g., plastic bags) or expanded polystyrene foam (e.g., Styrofoam)</p> |

| <p>Delivery Intercept</p> <p>\$17.6 per package</p> | <p>Applies when customer requests a return online. This surcharge is in addition to package's return shipping cost.</p> |

| <p>Large Package Surcharge</p> <p>\$105 (Commercial)</p> <p>\$130 (Residential)</p> | <p>1. Any package measuring more than <u>96 inches</u> in length</p> <p>2. Any package measuring more than <u>130 inches</u> in length and girth (H×2+W×2) combined</p> |
| <p>Over Maximum Limits</p> <p>\$920</p> | <p>1. Any package measuring more than <u>108 inches</u> in length</p> <p>2. Any package measuring more than <u>165 inches</u> in length and girth (H×2+W×2) combine</p> |
| <p>Residential Surcharge</p> <p>\$4.45 per package</p> | <p>3. Any package weighting more than <u>150 lbs</u></p> <p>Applies when delivering to a residential area or non-business area. (If you check the box for residential at ShipSaving platform, the listed price will automatically include this fee)</p> |
| <p>Delivery Area /Remote Area Surcharge</p> <p>\$4 - \$30 per package</p> | <p>A delivery area surcharge, \$4-\$30, applies to UPS Express and UPS Ground shipments destined for areas in Alaska and Hawaii or else, that are remote, sparsely populated or geographically difficult to access. Even California or New York zip codes might cause this surcharge.</p> |
| <p>SurePost Discount Disqualified</p> <p>(Could cause OVER \$30 surcharge)</p> | <p>When using SurePost service, dimensions and weight have to be very ACCURATE. If a package is over <u>9 lbs BILLABLE weight</u>, it will be disqualified for the discount and customer will have to pay for the original price of this shipment.</p> |
| <p>Shipping Charge Correction Audit Fee</p> <p>\$1.05 per package</p> | <p>An audit fee will be assessed when the average shipping charge correction for a package is greater than <u>\$2.00</u> subject to a shipping charge correction</p> |
| <p>Missing PLD Fee</p> <p>\$2 per package</p> | <p>A processing fee will be charged when the shipper does not provide all applicable Package Level Detail (PLD) information to UPS prior to delivery</p> |
| <p>Peak Surcharges</p> | <p>Visit ups.com/peaksurcharges for information on peak surcharges in effect, including applicable services, surcharge amounts and effective dates.</p> |

| Surcharge Name and Amount | Reasons (Effective Jan. 1st, 2021) |

| <p>Address Correction</p> <p>\$18 per package</p> | <p>Applies to incomplete, incorrect or P.O. box recipient address. DHL may attempt to determine the correct address, complete delivery and notify the shipper of the address correction</p> |
| <p>Remote Area</p> <p>\$42</p> | <p>Applies to a delivery that is remote, sparsely populated or geographically difficult to access.</p> |
| <p>Data Entry</p> <p>\$6.50 per package</p> | <p>Applies to each shipment consigned with non-electronic, paper based manual waybills. Electronic shipping documentation incurs no additional charges.</p> |
| <p>Fuel Surcharge</p> <p>(% of transportation and additional charges)</p> | <p>Applies to weight charge of each shipment and any transportation-related surcharges. Please visit dhl.com/fuelsurcharge to see the details.</p> |
| <p>Oversize Piece</p> <p>\$94 per piece</p> | <p>A fixed surcharge that applies to every piece, including a pallet, with a single dimension in excess of <u>48 inches</u> for shipments originating in the U.S. and U.S. Territories (<u>120 cm</u> for shipments originating outside of the U.S. and U.S. Territories)</p> |
| <p>Overweight Piece</p> <p>\$94 per piece</p> | <p>A fixed surcharge that applies to every piece, including a pallet, that exceeds a scale or volumetric weight of <u>150 lbs</u> for shipments originating in the U.S. and U.S. Territories (<u>70 kg</u> for shipments originating outside of the U.S. and U.S. Territories)</p> |
| <p>Non-Stackable Pallet</p> <p>\$245 per piece</p> | <p>This fixed surcharge that applies to every pallet within a shipment that cannot be stacked, either on request by the shipper, or because of its shape, content or packaging. This surcharge applies to domestic and international shipments</p> |

| Surcharge Name and Amount | Reasons (Effective Jan. 1st, 2021) |

| <p>Restricted Destination</p> <p>\$30 per package</p> | <p>Applies when shipping to a destination country that is subject to trade restrictions imposed by the UN Security Council. This charge will apply to all non-document shipments destined for the Central African Republic, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Eritrea, Iran, Iraq, Libya, North Korea, Somalia, Syria and Yemen.</p> |
| <p>Exporter Validation</p> <p>\$30 per package</p> | <p>Applies when shipping to a destination country that is subject to trade restrictions imposed by federal regulatory agencies such as the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC). This charge will apply to all non-document shipments destined for Afghanistan, Belarus, Lebanon, Myanmar and Zimbabwe. This charge may apply in addition to Elevated Risk</p> |
| <p>Elevated Risk</p> <p>\$20 per package</p> | <p>Applies when shipping to a destination country in which DHL is operating at elevated risk due to a continuous state of war, civil unrest or continuous threats from terrorism. This charge applies to all shipments destined for Afghanistan, Iraq, Libya, Mali, Niger, Syria and Yemen. This charge may apply in addition to either Restricted Destination or Exporter Validation.</p> |

Calculating Dimensional Weight

$$L \times W \times H \div 139 = \text{Total Cubic Square Inches}$$



1. Multiplying Length by width by height in inches. Round each measurement to the nearest whole inch. The resulting total is the cubic size of your package.
2. Dividing by 139 for U.S., Puerto Rico, and international shipments
