What is a Cookie?

Cookies are harmless text files that web servers can store on your computer's hard drive when you visit a website. Cookies enable users to navigate around websites, record which areas of the website have been visited and for how long and (where appropriate) enable us to tailor the content to fit the needs of visitors who have accessed the website. Why does Outfund use cookies?

Cookies are used on our website for the following purposes:

- for login purposes;
- to monitor and manage Site traffic;
- if required as a matter of law or regulation, to protect our or our other customers' rights;
- to enable us to remember preferences, track visitors and target adverts;
- to make the browsing experience on the Site more efficient and enjoyable; and
- We use both our own (first-party) and partner companies' (third-party) cookies to support these activities.

For avoidance of doubt, allowing out.fund to create a Cookie will not allow us to access your computer.

Cookie names (s)	Type of cookies	Purpose
_out_fund_session	Temporary session	This is used for authentication purposes and so that we can distinguish you from other users on the website.
Rails CSRF	Temporary session	Protects against cross-site request forgery.
Amplitude, Google Tag Manager	Analytics	We use these services to analyse and improve the performance of our website.
Hubspot	Customer support	Used for 'livechat' to connect you to one of our customer support representatives.

Is it possible to opt out of permitting cookies?

Yes, you are able to set your device to accept all cookies, to notify you when a cookie is issued, or not to receive cookies at any time. The last of these means that certain personalised services cannot then be provided to you and accordingly you may not be able to take full advantage of all of the features or services available on the out.fund website.
