

Cheapest Christmas staycations for Brits revealed

A leading UK marketplace for holiday rentals has revealed the top ten most affordable regions to go on a UK Christmas break, following data from the sixth annual Global Travel Forecast, which reported rising costs for flights, hotels and transport in 2020. Tyne and Wear topped the list of cheapest regions, followed by South Lanarkshire and Cambridgeshire.

One of the UK's leading marketplaces for holiday rentals has revealed the cheapest places to holiday in Britain during the Christmas period, as the cost of international travel is expected to rise for another year in 2020.

By analysing its internal data, [Snaptrip](#) has discovered the top ten cheapest regions for members of the public to holiday during the Christmas break. The list comes after the sixth annual Global Travel Forecast reported rising costs for air travel, hotels and ground transport globally for 2020.

1. Leicestershire - £324
2. Surrey - £353
3. South Yorkshire - £378
4. Nottinghamshire - £386
5. Wiltshire - £391

The 2020 Global Travel Forecast* published by CWT and GBTA, reviewed data from more than 60 countries and looks at the trends and developments that will shape the travel industry in the year ahead. According to the report, the cost of flights will rise by 1.2% in 2020, with hotels rising by 1.3% and rental cars up 1%.

Last year, the 2019 Global Travel Forecast** predicted a 2.6% rise in the cost of air travel, compared to a 3.7% rise for hotels.

Internal data from Snaptrip found that the average cost of a family holiday in the UK is £768 for a week, £528 for a mid-week break (Monday-Thursday) and £398 for a weekend during Christmas.
