

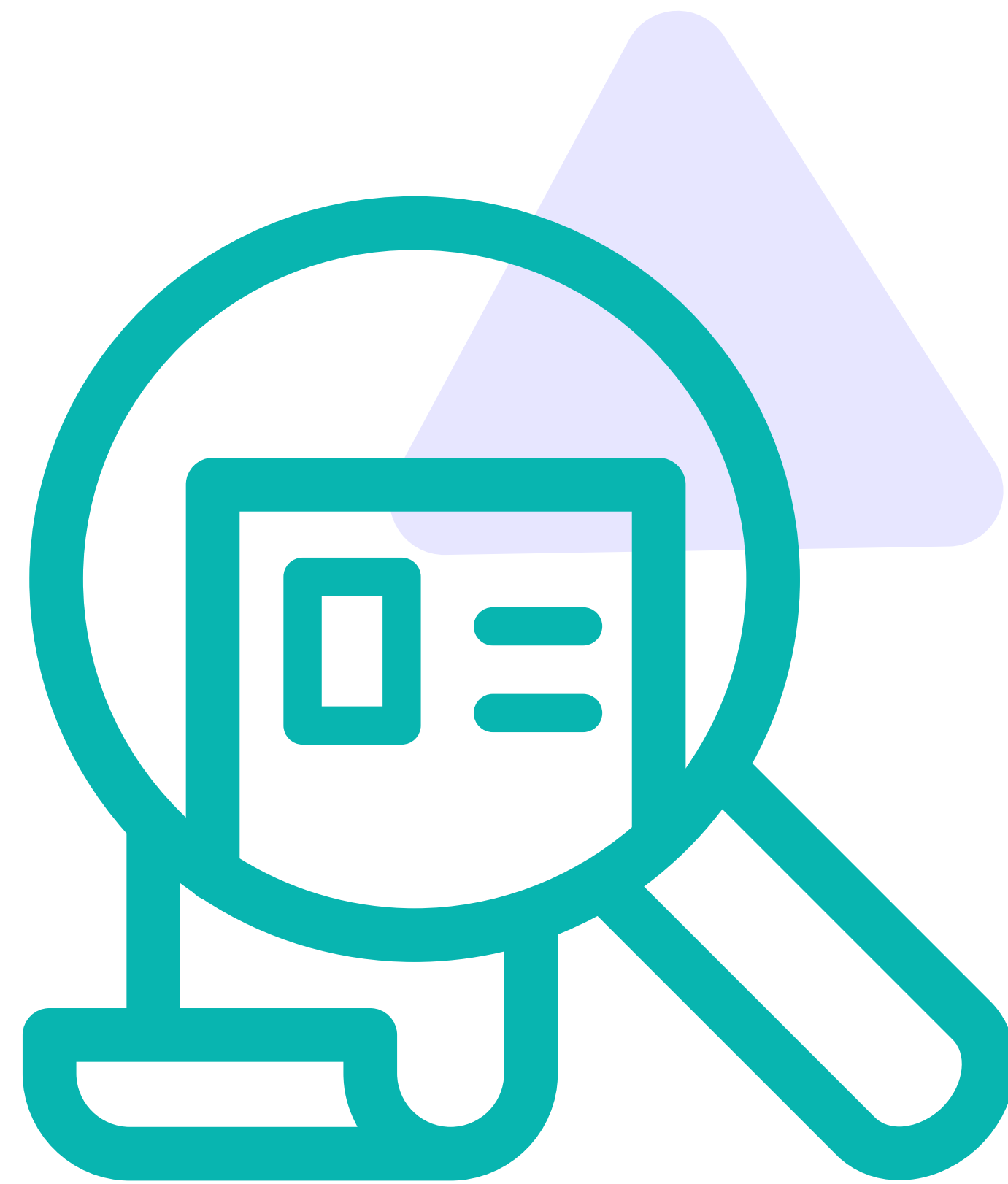
Tip #1

During Automation,
try to target the
complex tasks
at the end.

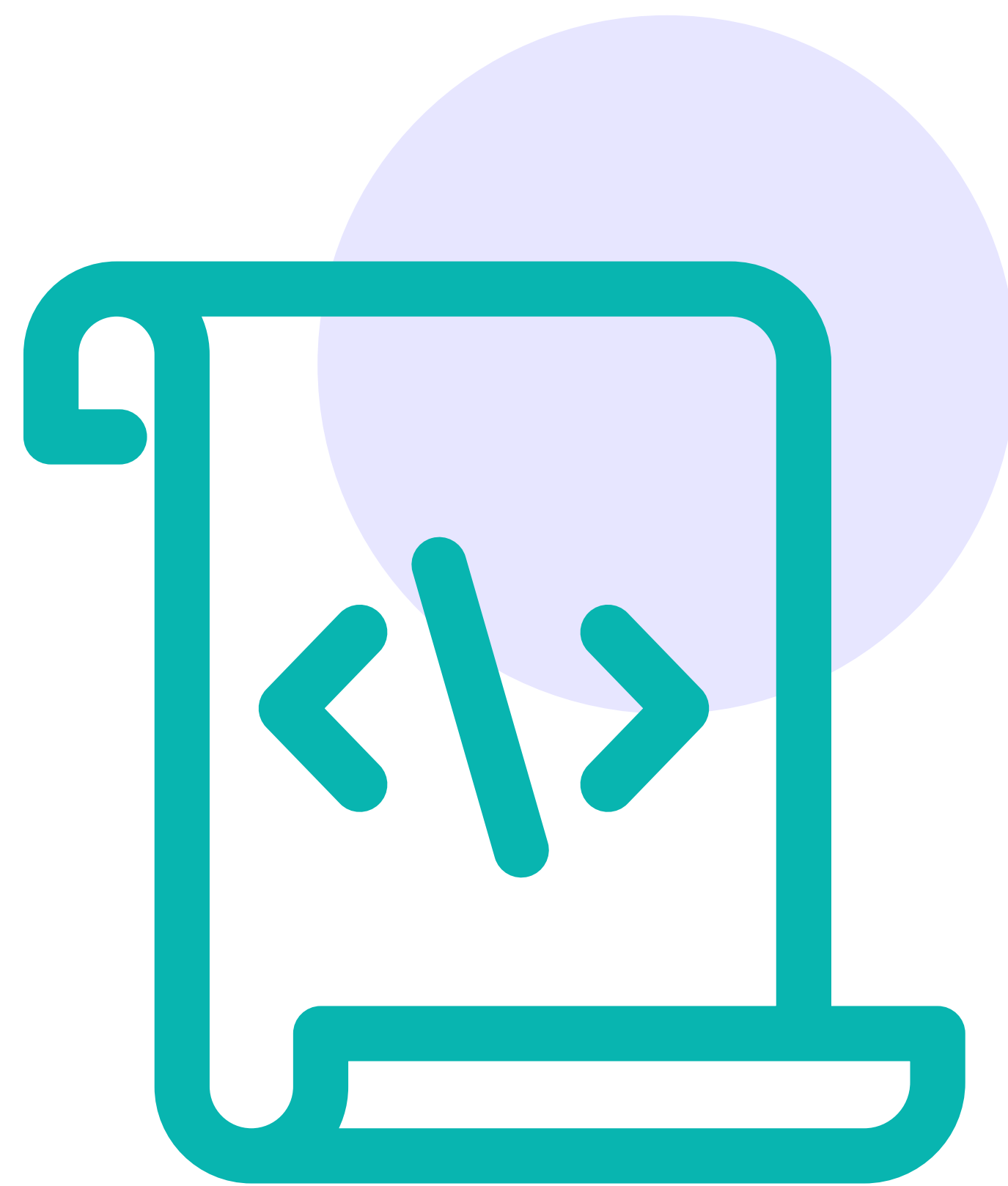

It is important to note that **100% Test Automation may not be possible.** Targeting the complex tasks at the end helps to proceed quickly.

How to do this?



Assess and Identify
specific screens or areas which
could be difficult to automate.



Also, while developing scripts, you may not be able to automate specific areas or screens. Temporarily procrastinate automation for all such screens.



Maintain a common repository that lists such screens so that it helps other team members as well.

How does this help you?

It helps increase the automation coverage quickly. Consequently, it **helps increase the team's confidence** during the automation.
