

Rijke alumni Delft en Rotterdam leggen miljoenen in voor nieuwe start-ups

In het kort

- Vermogende oud-studenten stellen miljoenen beschikbaar voor jonge techondernemers.
- Met een fonds van €3 min financieren ze jaarlijks twintig nieuwe start-ups in Deift en Rotterdam.
- Komend najaar volgt een groter vehikel, een zogeheten 'seed fund', waarvoor ook commerciële durfinvesteerders worden benaderd.

Philips-eco Frans van Houten, Pienie-oprichter Michiel Muller en andere vermogende oud-studenten stellen miljoenen beschikbaar voor jonge tech-ondernemers. Met een fonds van €3 mln financieren ze jaarlijks twintig nieuwe start-ups in Delft en Rotterdam. Na de zomer volgt een tweede fonds voor het 'opschalen' van deze bedrijfjes. Hun initiatief moet het succespercentage van start-ups verhogen.

Achter het plan zitten zo'n vijftig 'alumni' (afgestudeerden) van de TU Delft en de Erasmus Universiteit Rotterdam (EUR). Ze willen een sterk netwerk van nieuwe techbedrijven creëren. Daar zijn niet alleen meer starters voor nodig, maar ook een veel hoger percentage dat doorgroeit tot een volwassen bedrijf, een zogeheten 'scale-up'.

'In de VS breekt ruim de helft van de start-ups door', zegt Gert Jan van der Hoeven, een van de initiatiefnemers. 'In Nederland maar 16%. Dat is natuurlijk veel te laag. Het komt onder meer door een gebrek aan risicokapitaal in de eerste fase, maar ook doordat de starters niet genoeg hulp en advies krijgen.' Van der Hoeven is managing partner van

The Challenge | Dutch Entrepreneurship is underperforming on a global scale

Dutch universities are all part of the top 250 universities worldwide¹ However, when it comes to entrepreneurship we are severely underperforming.



Dutch startups have a conversation rate to scaleups (>10M funding) of only 17% – this is 51% in the USA²



Only 22% of academic Intellectual Property produces financial yields³





Funds | Graduate Entrepreneur has two fund: Pre-Seed and Seed

Pre-seed Fund

- *Aim:* boost the number of start-ups
- Fund size: €6M+
- *Tickets:* up to €75K
- Capital: provided through donations from alumni through University trust funds (ANBI status)
- Run by student board

Seed Fund

- Aim: develop selected start-ups to scale-ups
- *Fund size*: €35M €40M
- *Tickets:* €100K to €2M
- Capital: provided by alumniand universities
- Run by professional fund management team








What we have been up to...


- All aspects of the investment process (dealflow, due diligence, writing investment proposals, etc.)


