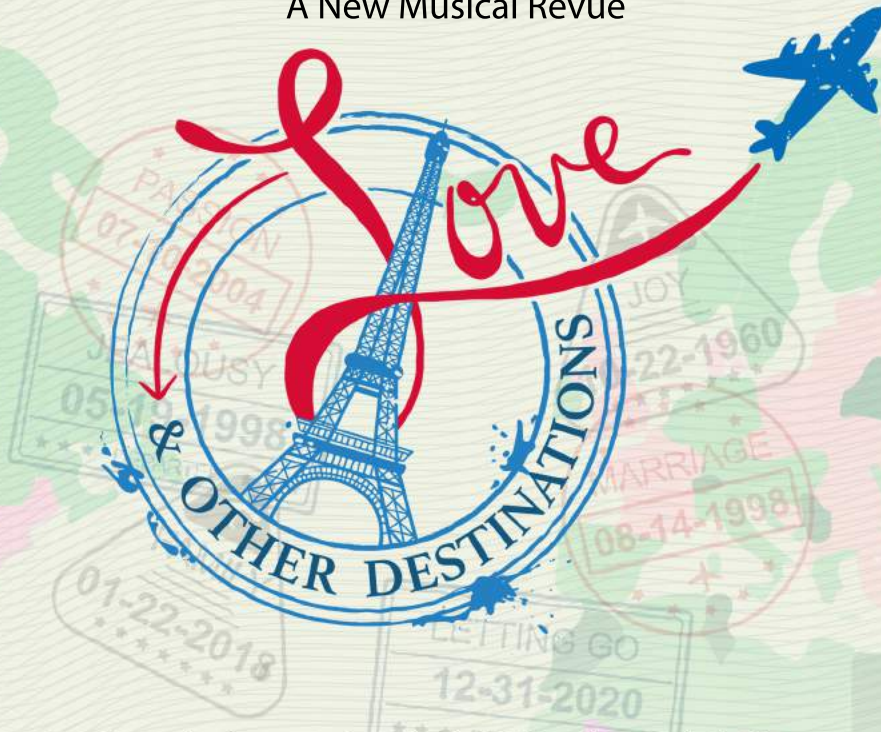


LOVE & OTHER DESTINATIONS
