bandcamp_Usability Test Affinity Findings

- 1. 4/5 users went to profile to find playlists
 - 2/5 users took a lot of time to find the playlists
 - 3/7 users on Maze gave up
 - 4/7 users on Maze used unexpected paths to get there
 - Could affect the bounce rate of users if the feature takes too long high priority
- 2. 4/5 users either tapped the wrong icon or hesitated before choosing the correct icon to add a song to a playlist
 - 2/4 Maze users clicked the heart button before the add to playlist button
 - All users completed the task medium priority
- 3. 4/5 users followed their friend back with ease
 - 2/5 users expected to see the word follow instead of an icon
 - One user did not complete the task (due to a prototyping error)
 - · One user said she expected the profile to be a settings-type page
 - 4/5 users found this task to be straight forward, however on Maze 3/5 users searched elsewhere before finding the page - medium priority
- 4. All users deleted the playlist task with ease

Trends for existing bandcamp features

- 1. 4/5 users wondered why there would be messages in a music app
- 2. All users were unsure about what the waves icon represented
