Conditions of Boat Hire

- By signing the booking form, you agree to take responsibility for the hire equipment until it is returned. Any damage must be notified and will be charged for.
- You will be in charge of the kayak and are responsible for its safe handling. Any damage caused to other boats or any other person is your responsibility.
- In the event of adverse weather conditions, we may have to cancel bookings.
- Kayaking is a dangerous sport, there is always danger of personal injury or death. By signing, you agree that you are aware of these dangers and accept the risks and that you are responsible for your own actions and involvement.
- Buoyancy aid must be worn at all times.
- The hirer will ensure hired equipment is kept in their possession at all times and is not left unattended.
- Where the hirer is transporting kayaks, they must have adequate means of strapping/securing the kayak/s. Argyll Kayaks can refuse hire if this is not the case.
- We understand that things can change, please let us know as soon as you are able if you have to cancel.
- Under COVID 19 restrictions, we are unable to adjust kayaks for you, footrests etc will have to be adjusted yourself. We will maintain 2m social distance and will wear mask and gloves. If you are suffering from Covid symptoms, please do not travel for your kayak hire. Let us know that you wish to cancel as soon as you can.

Kayaks will be disinfected after hire and buoyancy aids etc will be quarantined following current guidelines.
