SUMMER PROGRAMS DATES AND TIMES

The Summer Programs Office is located on the west end of the A.R. and Marylouise Tandy Dining and Wellness Center. The hours of operation are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

There will be seven, one-week sessions held between May 30 and July 21. Please note that there are several classes with special start times or end times that will be noted with an asterisk (*). See class descriptions for details.

CHOOSE A PLAN THAT WORKS FOR YOU

Structure your own day. Choose just a morning or afternoon session or stay all day with a morning session, lunch, then join a different afternoon session. Classes are available for 3-year-olds through adults. A wide variety of opportunities are available in both the morning and afternoon. Call the Summer Program office at (539) 476-8169 with any questions or for assistance in scheduling.

LUNCH

If staying for lunch, students should bring a sack lunch — no nuts please, plus a refillable water bottle. Lunch will be eaten in the Primary School lunchroom and Tandy Dining Hall.

SUMMER BEHAVIOR POLICY

All students enrolled in Holland Hall's Summer Programs must behave with cooperation and respect. Inappropriate behavior, as determined by the director, may jeopardize a student's privilege of attending.

ENTRANCE AND EXIT

The main 81st street gate is for entrance/exit, the middle gate is for entrance only and the Primary School east gate is for exit only.

Unless otherwise noted in the camp descriptions, Primary School camps will drop off and pick up in front of the Primary School flag pole. Middle School camps will use the main Tandy building entrance for drop-off and East circle drive for pick-up. Upper School camps will use the Upper School main wooden doors.

Sports camps will drop off and pick up at the Sports Drop-off indicated on the map, also noted in the course descriptions.

Please observe all posted speed signs (14 mph) and traffic signs. There will be many students on campus, and we want this to be a safe experience for everyone.

TUITION

Tuition and fees are listed with each session description and on the enrollment form. Classes will not be prorated by day. A one-time \$25 non-refundable registration fee will be assessed per student. Tuition and fees are non-refundable unless a course is canceled for insufficient enrollment. If that occurs, the student may select another session, or the tuition will be refunded. Payment in full is due at the time of online enrollment. Enrollment is not valid without payment.

HOW TO ENROLL

Enroll early – class sizes are limited and fill quickly. Complete the online registration and emergency authorization form for each student enrolling and pay online with your debit/credit card to secure your place in each camp. **Please note: If paying by check, it must be received by the Summer Programs office to secure a place in any camp.** Make checks payable to Holland Hall Summer Programs, 5666 E. 81st Street, Tulsa, OK, 74137-2099.

Each student must have a completed Information and Emergency Authorization and Release Form located at www.hollandhall.org/summer at the time of registration.

All students (1st-12th grade) attending athletic/sports camps must have had a physical within the past 13 months. Holland Hall students who do not have physicals on file with the school and all non-Holland Hall students must provide a copy of the physical with the enrollment.
