*In hot weather lettuces can suddenly run to seed.*

### peppery /'pep. ə r.i/ /-ə.i/ adjective

1. having a spicy flavour like pepper

*This salad has a sharp peppery flavour.*

### look forward to *sth* phrasal verb

1. to feel pleased and excited about something that is going to happen

*I'm really looking forward to my holiday.*

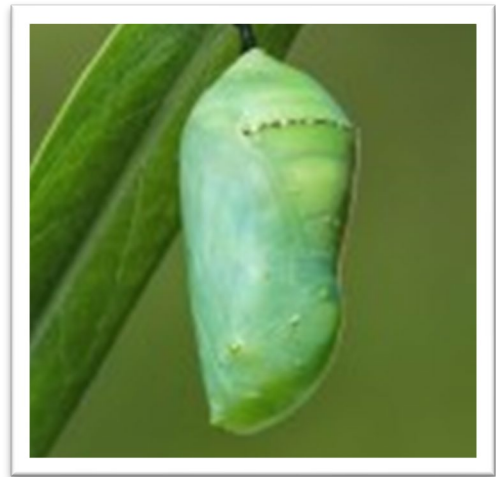
[ + -ing verb ] *She was looking forward to **seeing** the grandchildren again.*
