Life Group Questions to consider:

1.) Read 1 Corinthians 4:1-5.

In what ways do you see yourself as a servant of Christ and a steward of the mysteries of God? How does that perspective inform the way you value other people's opinions? How does that perspective hold you to a higher standard?

2.) Read 1 Corinthians 4:6-7.

Where are you tempted to become arrogant? How does continually returning to God's Word ground you in humility?

3.) Read 1 Corinthians 4:8-13.

What would need to change in your life for you to truly be a fool for Christ's sake? What struggles fight against wholeheartedly following Christ?

4.) Read 1 Corinthians 4:14-17.

How does your life imitate Paul's commitment to Christ? How does your life call others to imitate your following of Christ? How are you currently making disciples of Christ?

5.) Read 1 Corinthians 4:18-21.

Where does your life reflect a commitment like Paul shows to the church at Corinth? What is the power of the kingdom of God that goes beyond words? How are you giving and receiving spiritual correction?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives. Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken. Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
